## **CONTEXT AND OBJECTIVE:**

The organization of this Test Session falls within the framework of the Partnership Agreement established between UCLG Africa through its ALGA Academy and the French Agency for Ecological Transition (ADEME).

In this framework, a Module was developed on "Elaboration and Implementation of a Climate Plan at the Local Level" which both Partners agreed to adapt and adjust to the African context.

The objective of the Module is to strengthen the capacities of African territorial agents and executives on the management and animation of a Climate and Energy approach at the territorial level.

At the result of this training, the participants will be able to understand the climate, air quality and sustainable energy issues, and to lead a territorial development project. It aims to enable the acquisition of the skills needed to lead and manage the Territorial Climate and Energy Plan (PCET) of its territory. It will help to understand how the PCET fits into the territory's project, to identify how to deploy an efficient project mode organization, how to mobilize the key players, and will present the different structuring stages from the design to the implementation of a PCET.
